KIRKLAND-McCASKILL, Mrs. Izell - Age 73, passed away Sunday, May 22, 2005 at Genesys Health Park. Family hour 10:30AM Thursday, May 26, 2005 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church 5443 N. Izell Kirkland-McCaskill was born December 30, 1931 in Neshoha County, Philadelphia, Mississippi, the daughter of Sylvester and Ardie Kirkland. Sister Kirkland-McCaskill was a very warm and caring person. She was raised in a Christian home. She accepted Christ and was baptized at an early age at the Evening Light Church of God, in Philadelphia, MS. Izell received her education at Hopewell High School, and graduated with honors "Class of 1949." She also attended Alcorn A&M College. After moving to Flint in the early 50's, she united with 12th Street Church of God, now Flint Community Church of God. In the 70's, she became a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, where she served on the Senior Usher Board, until her health declined. Sis. Kirkland-McCaskill was employed many years with Herlick Drug Stores, the Flint Board of Education Custodial Dept and retired from Genesee Intermediate School District. Izell was a care provider to many neighboring children including the Bryant, Williams and

Forte' families. She loved music, sports, houseplants, knitting, gardening, family gatherings and especially loved watching baseball. Sis.
