Mrs. Jacqueline Brown was born March 15, 1947 in Flint, Michigan, the eldest daughter of Ophelia Matlock and Emmit Jenkins. Jacqueline graduated from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1965". She was employed for 20 years with General Motors, retiring in 1996 and was a member of UAW Local 651. Jacqueline devoted her life to Christ and her work spoke volumes about her love for the Lord. She was an active member of Greater Redeemed Tabernacle for 17 years. Jacqueline was the Pastor's Aide and fulfilled this position faithfully. "Sister Jackie" as she was affectionately called by her church family, held positions as the president of "Young People in Christ", where she worked with youth of all ages; Vacation Bible School Coordinator; head of the Outreach Ministry and Hospitality Committee.
