Jackie was the youngest child born to George & Myrtle Wiley. She graduated from Beecher High School in 1979. After graduation Jackie went to work at Hudson's where she spent many years in the shoe department. After leaving Hudson's she began working security for General Motors at L6 Engine Plant. Despite the jobs she held Jackie's true profession was a comedian. She loved to make people laugh and crack jokes. Her loud and boisterous laughter was contagious. Jackie accepted Christ as her personal Savior as a young adult and joined Christ Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church. She united in marriage to her high school sweetheart, Monty Lee Jackson and from that union they were blessed with two children, Monty & Monet. She took great pride in her children's accomplishments. Jackie believed it wasn't enough to be a good parent to your children but also a great friend. Jackie loved to cook and prepare specialty dishes for all who asked. Her macaroni & cheese,
