ADKISSON, Mr. James W., Jr. - Age 67, perished at his home on a bright winter morning, Saturday, 22 January 2011. Funeral Service 11 a.m. Saturday, January 29, 2011 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Master Chief (USN/Ret) James Waverly Adkisson, Jr. was born 12, February 1943 in Nashville, Tennessee, to Amanda Jacqueline and James Waverly Adkisson, Sr. His life can be characterized by a hard work ethic; unyielding devotion to his wife and family; loyalty to his country; lighthearted humor; and a crazy passion for fishing. In 1962, he joined the U.S. Navy and went off to Boot Camp. In 1963, he returned to Toledo to marry his high school sweetheart, Sharon Antoinette and proceeded to take her and four children all over the country for the next 30 years. He himself served mostly in the Pacific including; two tours in Viet Nam. In 1979, James was transferred to Flint, where he successfully and remarkably served in recruiting for the next 13 years until his retirement from the Navy in 1992. After only four months of fishing and hunting bliss, his work ethic got the best of him and he accepted a position with the Mike Abdullah branch of Monumental Insurance. He would tell you not cry and not to worry because he led a full, exciting, and happy life. He is survived by his wife, Sharon; daughters, Dana and Mya; son, James III.
