BEASLEY, Mr. James - Age 62, passed away Sunday, January 3, 2016 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Monday, January 11, 2016 at Greater Galilee Baptist Church, 4418 Industrial Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Min. Andre Williams, officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Monday. Mr. Beasley will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. Sunday.

Mr. James Elbert Beasley was born on September 7, 1953 in Secretary, Maryland, to the late Silas Elbert and Mattie Jean Beasley. James was Honorably Discharged from the U.S. Army and was employed at the VA Hospital after returning from the Vietnam War. Mr. Beasley served in the Vietnam War for 2 years and then went into the Reserve. James decorations and medals include: National Defense Service Medal, Marksman M16, and Expert 45. On August 21, 2010, James married his bride Zendelyn (McDaniel) Beasley. They enjoyed traveling together and visiting with family. James' hobbies included fishing on his dock, disc jockeying, and loved working on the Security Ministry at his church. James loved his grandchildren and loved to spend time with his family in Maryland, Virginia and Georgia. When Mr. Beasley wasn't with his wife and family he was working in his yard.



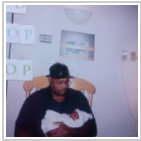
