BROWN, Mr. James Earl - Age 79, passed away Saturday, March 25, 2023, at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, April 8, 2023 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Saturday. Mr. Brown will lie in state in the chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday. Mr. James Earl Brown was born November 11, 1943 in Brookhaven, Mississippi, to the union of A.C. and Irea (Wilson) Brown. The family moved to Chicago, Illinois where he attended Wendell Phillips High School and furthered his education at Fisk University, Nashville, Tennessee. James began working at an early age for his uncle, cleaning the automotive shop. He also worked at the United States Post Office in Chicago, IL. James moved to Flint, Michigan where he began working at General Motors Corporation as a Committee Man, Attendance Coordinator and a Fork Lift Driver. He also worked at Flint Truck & Bus and retired from Buick City, both divisions of General Motors with 35 years of service. James was a member of God's Tabernacle Church for many years, where he was an Ordained Deacon. He later became a member of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church where he served on the New Member Committee. He worked on the Security Team and was a member of the Men's Choir. James was a faithful member for 30 years. He loved reading God's word and fellowshiping with his brothers

and sisters in Christ. James loved cooking, exchanging recipes with family and friends. He also loved to travel, being with family, old classic cars, basketball, football, singing, playing the guitar and piano. His favorite song was, "Don't Let The Devil Ride." James was a star basketball player at Wendel Phillips. He had a gift for story telling. On October 9th, 1993, he married the love of his life, Lorraine M. Brown. They were happily married for 29 years. He was very caring, respectful and quiet. James was a God-fearing man who lived, loved and served. He never met a stranger.
