CARTER, Mr. James Walter Sr. - Age 90, passed away Monday, November 2, 2015 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Thursday, November 12, 2015 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Mr. James W. Carter, Sr. was born July 24, 1925 in Aliceville, Alabama the son of Mr. Howard Corder and Ms. Sarah Phillips. He joined and served in the United States Navy during World War II; the Korean Conflict in 1945. Upon his return home, he received an Honorable Discharge. James then resided in Chicago, Illinois where he met Ms. Lucille Almore and the couple joined in Holy Matrimony. In 1954 they moved to Flint, Michigan where James was gainfully employed with Truck & Bus, a division of General Motors, then retiring after 25 years. He also operated Carter's Trucking Company for several years servicing the surrounding Flint area. James later took up residency in Las Vegas, Nevada where he stayed for 26 years. He owned and operated Pacific Towing Company for several years. James returned back to Flint where he chose to spend his last days with his family and friends. He was a brilliant, ambitious person who always kept a high spirit. His hobbies

included making and building things, especially with wood. James was also a great problem solver; there was no problem too great. He lived a very long fulfilling life and will be greatly missed.
