McClane. He was a faithful member and a dedicated servant on the Deacon Board. "James" genuinely enjoyed working in the church and would assist Pastor McClane on many occasions. James received his education at Burt High School, in Clarksville, TN. He developed great skills in many hobbies that he enjoyed; such as grilling. He loved to Barbeque. He loved traveling to Mississippi. James was very proud of his family and always wanted them to far exceed his accomplishments. James was employed full-time as a Cook at Bob Evans Restaurant in Flint, Michigan, where he worked faithfully for 25 years. After retiring from Bob Evans, he worked for the Family

Service Agency until his health failed. He served in the Army during the Vietnam War. After the Army, James met a beautiful young woman that he would soon marry. On December 16, 1972 James and Georgia Coleman were united in holy matrimony in Indianapolis, Indiana. To their union was born one son, Garry. On Wednesday, March 16, 2022, the Lord visited James room at the Hospice House in Owosso, Michigan, called his name and picked the best flower on his vine, and placed him in His Heavenly Garden.
