Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Wednesday. Mr. Knuckles will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed Monday from 2PM-8PM and Tuesday 9AM-8PM. Mr. James Edward Knuckles was born September 15, 1923 in Greenville, Georgia, the son of Oscar and Mary Knuckles. James was Honorably Discharged from the United States Army. He was united in marriage to Delories Williams 42 years until her death September 3, 1991. Mr. Knuckles was a faithful member of Foss Avenue Baptist Church for 51 years, where he served on the Senior Usher Board. He retired from General Motors after 35 years of service. Mr. Knuckles was a member and the president of GCARD's CYO #1 Council. He was also a member of Rose of Sharon Masonic Lodge #4. Mr. James E.
