



## Mr. Jerome Miller

July 3, 1950 - September 30, 2013

MILLER, Mr. Jerome - Age 63, passed away Monday, September 30, 2013 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Thursday, October 10, 2013 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 1083 E. Stewart Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Family and friends will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Thursday. Mr. Miller will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 noon-8 p.m. Wednesday.

The life of Jerome "Red" Miller, of Winston County, Louisville, Mississippi began on July 3, 1950. He was the second child of the late D.T. and Theora (Thompson) Miller. The family moved to Flint in 1951. Jerome confessed hope in Christ at an early age and united with the Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. He was an active community and church worker until his health failed. Monday afternoon, September 30, 2013, Jerome Miller's final chapter of life was completed at his residence, under the caring watch of his care giver, Suzette Hatifield and wife, Fatima.
