OLIVER, Mr. Jerome W., Jr. - Age 80, passed away Sunday, August 29, 2010 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Mr. Jerome William "Jerry" Oliver, Jr. was born January 7, 1930 in Inkster, Michigan. His mother Zada Moss died when he was six. His parents were Jerome "Jim" and Alyce Oliver. He was the eldest of six children; (twins) Jacqueline and Shirley, Lovella, Kenneth and Sandra. Jerome married his devoted wife of 56 years, Adrienne Oliver on February 5, 1954. They have two daughters, Stephanie Henderson, adopted daughter, Diane (Vernie) Owens and three sons, Shelton Stinson, Jerome W. "Jappy" Oliver III, and adopted son, Arthur Henderson. "Jerry" graduated from Inkster High School where he was a sports stand-out and excelled in Fine Arts. He attended Alabama State on a football scholarship after which "Jerry" enlisted in the United States Army from 1951-1954, where he served as a Sergeant in the Korean Conflict. Upon returning from his military service, he began working for Truck and Bus, a division of General Motors, retiring after 31 years of service. "Jerry" was active with the United Auto Workers (UAW) where he was a Committeeman and UAW Representative. After retirement he started a landscaping business with his

nephew Reginald Spencer, serving neighbors and friends. "Jerry" enjoyed keeping an immaculate home inside and out, he loved decorating his home especially at Christmas. "Jerry" was devoted to his family and he enjoyed entertaining friends. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed deer hunting and fishing. "Jerry" was also a longtime member of the South Dort Highway McDonald's Breakfast Bunch. One of his greatest passions was sports; following the high school and college football teams and the coaching career of his loving son "Jappy".
