



Mrs. Jerquetter "Jackie" Knapp

July 27, 1934 - January 22, 2015

KNAPP, Mrs. Jerquetter "Jackie" - Age 80, passed away Thursday, January 22, 2015 at Amberwood Care Center in Illinois. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Thursday, January 29, 2015 at First Trinity Missionary Baptist Church, 1226 Beach St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Ezra Tillman officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Thursday. Mrs. Knapp will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 2-8 p.m. Wednesday.

Mrs. Jerquetter "Jackie" Knapp was the oldest child of Linwood and Bertha Henry, born July 27, 1934 in Jonesboro, Arkansas where she graduated from Booker T. Washington School. Shortly after Mrs. Knapp moved to New York City where she attended Columbia University. She later moved back to Jonesboro where she became the first African American to work in the local banking system. In 1969, Mrs. Knapp moved to Flint, Michigan where she united with First Trinity Baptist Church where she shortly after became the church pianist. Mrs. Knapp worked for the Genesee County Treasurer office. After retiring she was employed as the financial secretary for First Trinity until her health failed.
