MAXWELL, Mr. Jerry Wyatt - Age 71, passed away Tuesday, May 10, 2016 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, May 24, 2016 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 a.m. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Family and friends will assemble at the funeral home 10:30 a.m. Tuesday. Mr. Maxwell will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Monday.

Mr. Jerry W. Maxwell was born October 17, 1944, in Los Angeles, California, the son of Hosey Wyatt. He gave his heart to Christ at an early age in Hope, AR. Later after moving up north he joined the Divine Grace Ministries Church. Jerry attended school at Northwestern High School in Detroit, MI and returned to Hope, AR and graduated from Henry C. Yerger High School, "Class of 1963." He served in the United States Army for 3 years where he was wounded in the Vietnam War. Jerry was discharged and received an Honorable Discharge and a Purple Heart Medal. He returned to Flint, Michigan and was employed at the United States Postal Service, delivering mail at the Northside Station where he retired. When Jerry's health began to fail, he sent for his childhood best friend to come and take care of him, Mrs. Wilma Franks. She cared for him for 7 years and 4 months.

Mr. Jerry W. Maxwell leaves to cherish his memory: son, Eric Strickland; daughter, Monica Bradford; step-son, Dennis McLay of Killeen, TX; 3 sisters-in-law, Peggy of Atlanta, GA, Mildred of Arkansas and Toney of Detroit, MI; brother-in-law, Danny McLay; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends including special military friend, Mr. Eddie Stovall that always called him "my brother for life."

Mr. Maxwell was preceded in death by his wife, Jerry Maxwell; brother, Bufford Wyatt.
