STOUDAMIRE, Mr. Jesse, Jr. - Age 88, passed away Friday, May 6, 2011 at Heartland-Fostorian Nursing Home. Family hour 10AM Thursday, May 12, 2011 at Quinn Chapel A.M.E. Church, 2101 Lippincott Blvd., with funeral service at 11AM. Pastor Stanley U. Sims officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM. Military Honors will be handled by VFW. Mr. Stoudamire will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Wednesday. Mr. Jesse Stoudamire, Jr. was born July 10, 1922 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas to the late Jesse Sr. and Julia (Dorn) Stoudamire. On August 29, 1947 he entered into Holy Matrimony to his beloved Mattie Amanda (Coleman-Rogers) his soul mate, whom preceded him in death, November 1, 1992, now reunited in Heaven with God. Jesse was a life-long, faithful member of Quinn Chapel A.M.E. Church. Jesse proudly served this country in the U.S. Army during WWII and was equally proud being a member of New Lothrop VFW Post #6579 serving three years as commander with final position as Chaplain.
