Mr. Jessie James Patrick age 84, as born July 21, 1941, in Decatur, Mississippi, the second eldest of 12 children born to Isaiah Sr. and Vera Mae (Towner) Patrick. Although he arrived as a Fraternal Twin, he was the "True Grit Of The Family."
