Mr. Jessie Rogers, Sr. was born October 20, 1929 in Starkville, Mississippi, the son of Willie and Nimmia Rogers. He accepted Christ as a child at Plair United Methodist Church in Starkville, MS. While in Starkville he drove trucks and was known as "Borat". Mr. Rogers married Mandy Deloach on September 20, 1952. They relocated to Evanston, IL and from there to Flint, MI in 1963. He worked for General Motors for 35 years "Chevy in the hole" and was a member of UAW Local 659, retiring in November 2001. Mr. Rogers loved his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.
