He attended public school in Sheridan, AR and was affiliated with the Piney Woods School in MS. Jessie was united in holy matrimony to Willie B. Harness on May 3, 1980. He resided in Flint, MI for 53 years, where he was a member of Christ Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church and was the Assisting Treasurer of the church, a member of the Trustee's Board and Sunday School.
