SILK, Mrs. Jewel - Age 82, passed away Sunday, May 22, 2022 at her residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, May 28, 2022 at Worship Temple C.O.G.I.C., 2902 Leith St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Saturday. Mrs. Silk will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday. Mrs. Jewel (Scruggs) Silk was born on November 27 1939 in St. Louis Missouri, the daughter of Charles and Josephine (Henley) Scruggs. The Scruggs family moved to Flint, Michigan in 1945. Mrs. Silk attended the Flint Community Schools and graduated from Flint Central High School, "Class of 1957." She was united in Holy Matrimony on May 14, 1959 to Bobby E. Silk. God blessed her to reach her 63rd anniversary on last Saturday. From that union two children were born, Karen Rene' Silk-Adams and Drake Thomas Silk Sr. Mrs. Silk retired with 30 years of Service from A.C. Spark Plug, a division of General Motors Corporation as a Job Setter and Floor Inspector and was a member of Local #659. Mrs. Silk was a born entrepreneur, skilled in financial literacy with an ambitious desire to establish generational wealth for her family. She founded Scradabanks and Associates; teaching Financial Literacy, Wealth Building, and Tax Consulting. Mrs. Silk was a skilled Seamstress with the ability to sew from scratch without the need of a pattern. She was also a skilled Beautician graduating from Searcy School of Cosmetology. Mrs. Silk was an Event planner, Wedding

director and fundraiser to sponsor youth activities abroad in addition to hosting family reunions for the Henley family. Mrs. Silk was a faithful follower of Christ and was baptized at the age of 16 years old at New Zion Baptist Church in Flint. In 1968, Mrs. Jewel Silk joined in fellowship with Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church in Flint, where she was a dutiful member of the church serving as a Church Clerk and on the Women's Usher Board. At the age of 27, Mrs. Silk suffered heart failure and was diagnosed with Lupus disease. She was in a coma for two and a half months. Her family was told she wouldn't survive. However, she was aware and asked God to bring her home to her kids and she would dedicate them to the Lord. God heard her prayer and immediately her eyes flew open. She returned home to her children and kept her promise taking her children and grandchildren to church. Mrs. Silk faithfully evangelized for the church bringing many family members to Christ and their descendants which are still members to this day. In 1999 Mrs. Jewel Silk joined Mount Nebo Missionary Baptist church where she taught Sunday School often walking down the street to services. She expressed great appreciation for her spiritual leaders, Pastors Lindell L. Brady, Marvin A. Jennings & T.J. Lee Jr. She loved her community and had a heart to serve. No one was ever lacking in her presence. Mrs. Silk was affectionately called "Granny" to many children regardless of whether they were her true grandchildren or not. Her husband jokingly referred to her as Mother Theresa because she was so generous. She would organize trips and take all the neighborhood children to Boblo Island, Cedar Point, Kings Island, Six Flags, and the Kellogg's Plant in Battle Creek. When her grandchildren were in High school she worked the concession stand to send her granddaughter and other students to Italy & Greece. She organized fundraisers so no child was left behind. Mrs. Silk loved everyone but her grandchildren & great-great children were her pride and joy. She was a constant presence in their lives. She was their biggest cheer leader and supporter in all their endeavors. She promised to look over her grandchildren even from heaven above. Mrs. Silk lived a full and fruitful life despite her many illnesses. Doctors told her she would never

walk, drive a vehicle, or work. But her favorite motto was “There’s no such thing as CAN’T” and she often quoted Philippians 4:13 “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me”. Although she endured chronic pain she never complained and accomplished all she set out to do. Mrs. Jewel (Scruggs) Silk leaves to cherish her memory: husband, Bobby E.
