November 6, 1938 - March 24, 2020

TURNER, Mr. Jimmie, Sr. - Age 81, passed away Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, April 4, 2020 at First Union Baptist Church, 7004 Fleming Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM, Pastor Archie Powell Jr., Host Pastor, Rev. Ulysses Harrison, officiating. Interment Gracelawn Community Cemetery, G-5710 N. Saginaw St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Saturday. Mr. Turner will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1:00 PM-8:00 PM Friday.

Mr. Jimmie Turner Sr. was born November 6, 1938 Bolivar, Tennessee, the son of Robert Turner Sr. and Lula Mae Hunt. Jimmie attended Allen White High School in Whiteside, TN where he completed all grades up until the 12th grade. In his senior year of high school, Mr. Turner was unable to finish due to being drafted into the United States Army on October 28, 1957 serving 3 years of Active Duty in Korea, then 2 years in the Reserves being Honorably Discharged on December 31, 1962. Jimmie moved to Flint, Michigan after his tour in Korea ended in 1960 where he met the love of his life, Cora Lee Hudson and they married in February 1963. Jimmie worked as a Short Order Cook at Walgreen's, later becoming a Custodian, Mechanical Engineer and Air Conditioning Technician, all with the Flint Board of Education until retiring in 2000. Mr. Jimmie Turner gave his life to Christ becoming a member of First Union Baptist Church in 1991, where he served as one of the founders of S.O.S. (Save Our Sons) and a faithful member of the Mighty Male Choir.

Jimmie loved spending time with his family, traveling, watching western movies, listening to Motown/Blues records and playing Bid Wiz with the gang at Hasselbring Senior Center.

Mr. Jimmie Turner Sr. leaves to cherish his memory: 3 daughters, Sherry, Michelle and Teresa Turner; 2 sons, Jimmie Jr. and Daniel Turner, all of Flint; grandchildren, Shamere Turner of Rosharon, TX, Charles Malone, DéQuan Turner, Travonta and Talaila Turner, Micah Hester, all of Flint; great-grandchildren, Harmony Malone and Zanariey McNeal, both of Flint; god-son, Herman Smith Jr.; god-grandchildren, Kelvin Turner and Shaniyah Smith of Flint; 4 sisters-in-law, Tee Willie Cobb of Fairborn, OH, Mary Nell Hudson of Selmer, TN, Myrtle Hudson of Memphis, TN and Maccen Hudson; 2 brothers-in-law, Curtis and Joe Hudson, all of Flint; a host of other relatives and friends. Mr. Turner was preceded in death by his devoted wife, Cora Lee Turner; son, Byron Turner; parents, Robert Turner Sr. and Lula Mae (Charles) Miller; brother, Robert Turner Jr.; and sister-in-law, Ophelia Turner.
