Stewart was born August 24, 1934 in Tylertown, Mississippi to the late Kirby and Mattie Stewart. In 1954, he united in Holy Matrimony to Ms. Mildred Thigpen and to this union four children were born. In the early 60's the family moved to Flint, Michigan. Mr. Stewart was a Foundry Worker and a Production Line Operator for Buick Motor, a Division of General Motors, where he later retired and was a active member of UAW Local 599. His hobbies included taking road trips, fishing and watching major league baseball. Mr. J.L.
