She also taught Educable Mentally Retarded and Learning Disabled and Emotionally Impaired for Carman Ainsworth District. She was a Title One teacher in Carman Ainsworth District and the first Parent Advocate for the Flint School District. JoAnn was a member of the National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women's Club, Inc., Alpha Kappa Sorority, Eastern Michigan Adahi Honorary Society and Phi Delta Pi Society. She also was a former member of Greater Flint Afro American Hall of Fame, Golferettes League, Inner City Golf League, Executive Board of Carman Ainsworth Education Association and the Flint

Board of Education. JoAnn was an avid reader. She enjoyed singing in the choir, golfing, traveling, and sports in general. She also loved arts and crafts, her hats and suits, spending time with her family and friends.
