Mr. Jonathan David Eichelberger was born June 5, 1980 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Rev. David and Sherri Eichelberger. Jonathan was a resident of Flint and a member of Jackson Memorial Temple C.O.G.I.C. He attended Flint Northern High School, Mott Community College, Flint Institute of Music and traveled throughout Europe with the Youth Ambassadors. Jonathan was employed at General Motors, Buick Division and was a member of UAW Local #599. He was affectionately called "Smiley" because his smile would win the hearts of all he came into contact with.
