Joseph accepted Jesus Christ for his Lord and Savior at an early age. He joined Mt. Hermon Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of his uncle the late Pastor A.V. Henry, where his membership remained under the leadership of Dr. K.D. Yarber. He sang in the Mass Choir and served on the Usher Board there. Joseph moved to Albion, MI where he joined the Leggett Chapel AME Zion Church under the leadership of the former Pastor Earnest Harris. He sang in the Male Chorus, assisted with landscaping, maintenance, and keeping the church grounds.
