JONES, Mr. Joseph - Age 77, passed away Tuesday, April 22, 2008 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 12Noon Saturday, April 26, 2008 at Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, 2109 M.L. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 4PM-8PM Friday. Mr. Joseph Jones was born January 11, 1931 in Newton, Mississippi, the son of Ferry and Lalar Jones. He was a resident of Flint, MI and proudly served his country in the United States Marines Corp during the Korean Conflict. Joseph worked at Flint Truck and Bus Assembly for 46 years and was a member of Flint UAW Local #598. He was a member of Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, where he served faithfully as a Deacon on the Deacon's Board and as president of the Male Chorus. Mr. Joseph Jones leaves to cherish his memory: wife, Mary F.
