Washington High School in 1956. She moved to Flint, Michigan in 1966 in pursuit of employment. Juanita secured work at AC Spark Plug Division where she worked for 30 years before retiring. After retirement, Mrs. Palmer was able to pursue her many different hobbies. In 1968 Juanita married Leonard C. Palmer, Sr. her husband of 46 years creating a loving, blended family.
