RANDALL, Mr. Judge - Age 100, passed away Wednesday, August 26, 2020 at his residence. Mr. Randall will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., Wednesday, September 2, 2020 from 12:00 PM - 3:00 PM.

Mr. Judge Randall age 100, was born January 9, 1920 in Sicily Island, Louisiana, the son of Ambrose and Louise Randall. Born the last of 8 children graduating from Catahula Parish in Jonesville, LA. Mr. Randall entered the military in January 29, 1942 and became a Corporal serving in the United States Army World War II where he was Honorably Discharged in November of 1945.

Mr. Randall retired in January 1989 from SPO Parts Plant, a division of General Motors Corporation after 35.2 years of service. He was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church where he was just honored as being one of the oldest and faithful members. Mr. Randall enjoyed reading his Bible, "The Price Is Right" and staying out of others way.

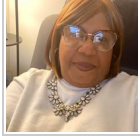
