Juwan will be remembered for his thought-provoking and funny phrases (such as “because it’s Tuesday”) which fostered many opportunities for the development of character and unmatched critical thinking skills in his students.

Juwan was an accomplished automotive instructor with many awards and accolades. He was an ambitious and innovative leader at Oakland Schools Technical Campus Northeast (OSTC-NE) in Pontiac, Michigan. He had a goal to build the best high school automotive program in the country.

Juwan was a member of the Michigan Education Association, and in 2022, he was named the Byrl Shoemaker Instructor of the Year by the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence Education Foundation. In 2023, he was named a \$100,000 Grand Prize Winner of the Harbor Freight Tools for Schools 2023 Prize for Teaching Excellence.

Juwan's passion for teaching was only surpassed by his deep love for his family. He was a sweet, loving, and thoughtful father. He will be missed for the way he would answer his children's phone calls with a loving "hello my baby." An amazing biological father of six, and father figure to many more, he navigated parenthood with a blend of unwavering dedication and the occasional touch of stubbornness, creating a home filled with love and life lessons.

Juwan's mind was a treasure trove of uniqueness, offering perspectives that illuminated the world around him. His creativity and distinct thinking enriched the lives of those fortunate enough to share in his journey. He leaves behind a tapestry of memories, each woven with his laughter, wisdom, and the warmth of his affectionate nicknames.
