After graduation, she moved to Flint and attended Flint Junior College, now known as Mott Community College. She briefly taught school and was later hired at A.C. Spark Plug, a division of General Motors. She was a member of Local 651. Katie married Luther Guy Sr. and to this union, two children were born, Linda Irene and Luther. Katie was a former member of Greater Holy Temple where she served as Vice President of the Youth Department with the late Superintendent James Cooper. In 1966, she move her membership to Fairhaven Seventh Day Adventist Church where she served on the Alter Guild and the Kings Daughter Circle until her illness prevented her from participating. She was also

president of the clothing closet for several years giving to the needy. She was very involved in the community and church for speaking her mind and saying just what she meant. Katie was known for always helping the less fortunate and those in need. She was an avid reader and loved to read the word of God. She played the piano for several ministries in the city of Flint. She was very protective of her family, children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Katie had many adopted daughters and sons from every walk of life. She was known as "Mama Guy" or "G.G." Her grandchildren gave her the name G.G. (GreatGrand Mother).
