PARRIS, Mr. Keith Edward - Age 64, passed away Thursday, February 20, 2025 at Corewell Health Blodgett, Grand Rapids, MI. Family hour 10:00 AM Monday, March 10, 2025 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Keith Edward Parris (affectionately called "Sug Edward" by his Aunt Dorothy) was born on September 10, 1960, in Detroit, MI, to Frances (Parris) Cleaves and Clifford Parris. He accepted Christ as his Savior at an early age and deeply valued his spiritual relationship with God. Keith attended Flint Public Schools and graduated from Flint Northern High School in 1978. A natural athlete, he excelled in basketball, football, and wrestling – even earning the title of State Champion in 1978 during his time at Flint Northern. His dedication and talent led to his induction into the Greater Flint Area Sports Hall of Fame in 2014. A true sports enthusiast, Keith carried his love for athletics throughout his life. In June 1981, Keith enlisted in the United States Army, where he proudly served his country. He was Honorably Discharged in 1984 and remained committed to lifelong learning, earning several certifications throughout his career. Keith's faith was evident in his love for family and community. A dedicated servant, he generously gave his time to volunteering,

often helping at homeless shelters and rescue missions. He was actively involved in the Veterans Association and Hero's Corner, always seeking ways to uplift and support others. Blessed with a beautiful singing voice, many compared him to Philip Bailey of Earth, Wind & Fire. As a child, he would put on concerts for his family, cousins, and friends bringing joy to those around him. He cherished time with family and found happiness in their company. Keith had a gift for organization and an innate ability to improve everything he touched. He left a lasting impact on those who knew him, not just through his actions, but through the kindness and dedication he showed every day.
