Kelvin was baptized at an early age at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church and he attended Mount Hope Church in Lansing, MI. He graduated from Flint Central High School in 1974 and from from Lansing Community College-Institute of Photography in 1995. Kelvin was a professional photographer. He worked for General Motors as a Die Maker for 31½ years and was a member of UAW Local #659. Kelvin was an outdoorsman who loved camping, hunting, fishing and traveling. He was an avid jogger who enjoyed running track and cross-country. Kelvin also was a very giving person always lending a helping hand to someone in need.
