JACKSON, Mr. Kenneth - Age 78, passed away Sunday, December 19, 2021 at his residence. Family hour 1:30 PM Wednesday, December 29, 2021 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Funeral Home, 1:30 PM Wednesday. Mr. Jackson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12:00 PM-6:00 PM Tuesday. Mr. Jackson was Honorably Discharged from the United States Air Force and was a Vietnam Veteran. Mr. Kenneth Jerome Jackson was born October 6, 1943 in Flint, Michigan, the son of David L. and Carrie L. (Tolbert) Jackson. Kenneth was a resident of Flint and a member of Quinn Chapel A.M.E. Church where he served on the Trustee Board for 15 years. He graduated from Flint Southwestern High School, "Class of 1961." Kenneth joined the United States Air Force where he served for 3 years and 9 months. He married Pamela Moten on June 29, 1968 and to this union was born, Krisha Louise, Kevin Maurice and James "JC" Coleman, along with 9 grandchildren. Kenneth enjoyed watching sports, especially his beloved Michigan State Spartans. His favorite movie was The Christmas Story. He loved to listen to jazz, Motown and Christmas Music.
