(Stallings) and Raymond L. Felder. Kevin was a member of House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church. He graduated from Northwestern High School, "Class of 1990," there he played baseball, wrestled, played in the band and was a varsity football player #39. Kevin went on to attend Northern Michigan University in Marquette, MI, where he also played football #99. He graduated with a degree in Criminal Justice with a minor in Business Administration. Kevin was currently working on his Master's Degree in Counseling at Eastern Michigan University. Kevin had many positions over his career, but always had employment helping people as a social worker.
