Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Thursday. Ms. Kimberly KenYonn Hughes was born November 26, 1978 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Jimmie E. Hughes and Bruce A. Hughes. She united with Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church at an early age. After moving to Wayne Michigan, Kimberly joined with the Cornerstone Metro Church under the leadership of Pastor Larry Mack, where she served as one of the instructors in the dance ministry. Kimberly attended Flint Public Schools, graduating from Flint Northwestern High School "Class of 1996". During her high school years, she was very active in various activities and organizations. She was also involved with the People to People organization, traveling to Australia. Kimberly attended Central Michigan University pledging, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, while graduating August 2001 and was to complete her masters degree study from Central Michigan University in August of 2006.
