April 18, 1918 - December 11, 2005

WILLIAMS, Mr. Lacie - Age 87, passed away Sunday, December 11, 2005 at his residence. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-8PM Friday. Mr. Lacie Williams was born April 18, 1918 in Pioneer, Louisiana, the son of Robert and Susie (Kenner) Williams. Lacie was a member of Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church since 1996. He was a hardworking man, and was proud of the fact that in 44 years of service at General Motors, he missed less than 44 days of work. After working on a special project at the Chevrolet Plant, a few presses had broken down and ran behind on parts. Mr. Williams stayed three days straight to complete the job. His supervisor later asked him what job he wanted, he replied with "to be trained as a millwright to make more money to feed my family." His request was granted and he later helped others become millwrights as well. Lacie was known for working hard and rigging something until it worked. Wires could go from here to there, but if the buzzer buzzed or the light came on, he was satisfied. Other than working his next love was his dogs. There have been many over the years and his last two; Lucy and Mobley were dear to his heart. When he was in rehabilitation his dear friend Jerome brought them by and let

them run around outside his room window. Seeing his dogs, Lacie was determined to leave rehab and be home with his dogs!
