He began his career in the United States Air Force as a Missile Electrician and received an honorable discharge. Larry and Rose were married for 48 years. He will be remembered as a wonderful husband, father, brother and friend. He, above all, was a dedicated family man. He loved his family and was extremely committed to his wife and three daughters, Wendy, Kerry and Tenice. He loved and respected his wife deeply. 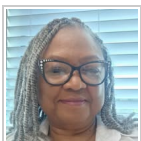

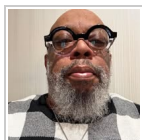
