Phillips School of Nursing in St. Louis, Missouri. She was employed as a Registered Nurse at Homer G. Phillips Hospital. In November 1973, Laura moved to Flint, MI and was employed as a Registered Nurse at Flint General Hospital. In 1997 Laura received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Health Care and Human Behavior. She was a Registered Nurse for over 47 years and employed as a Registered Nurse at Hurley Medical Center, retiring in December of 2002, with over 24 years of service. Laura accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior at an early age and was a member of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church for over 31 years. She loved music and good cooking.
