Mother Lavada Jackson was born in Smackover, Arkansas to Dave and Sula (Fogel) Henderson, she was the 3rd child of eight children. She attended Smackover Training School in Arkansas. Lavada married Joseph Jackson and to this union was born 2 lovely daughters. Mrs. Jackson later moved to Flint, MI and was employed by Chevy Truck and Bus and was a member of Local 598, and later retired in 2000. She was a very faithful member of North Star Baptist Church where she served on the Mothers Board and had recently joined the Nurses Guild until her health failed. Mrs. Jackson loved working in her yard and keeping it beautiful, she also loved shopping, traveling, being with her grand babies, and her family.
