

## Mr. Lawrence Thomas Moore Jr.

September 29, 1942 - November 18, 2020

MOORE, Mr. Lawrence - Age 78, passed away Wednesday, November 18, 2020 at Angel Manor, Clio, MI. Family hour 10:30 AM Wednesday, November 25, 2020 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Elder Shelton Matthews, officiating, South Side Church of God, Pontiac, MI. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10:00 AM Wednesday. There will be no public viewing. Mr. Lawrence Thomas Moore, Jr. was born on September 29, 1942, in Flint, Michigan. He was the first born to the union of Lawrence T. Sr. and Katheryne E. (Holley) Moore. Lawrence worked for General Motors for 38 years and retired as a Parts Supervisor. He loved attending church services and enjoyed sharing about his family very much – often recalling stories of his children and grandchildren.

Lawrence and his wife Regina (who preceded him in death), united in fellowship with the South Side Church of God, in Pontiac, Michigan in 2003. Early Sunday mornings, a bright, shining Cadillac would be there in the parking lot of the church, before most of the saints arrived. Out would step a very refined gentleman, suitably dressed from head to toe, eager to gather the congregation for worship. He loved bringing his granddaughter, Nyjina, to church with him. He delighted in leading the song to begin our worship service, “This Is The Day The Lord Has Made.” He professed his belief in Christ and accepted him as Lord and Savior.

Lawrence developed a great love for his Pastor, and enjoyed many times of fellowship with him, and the Brotherhood of the church. He would ask, "Pastor, what can I do to help the church?" The "Mission Statement" we now follow, our dear brother very diligently helped to develop. He believed, "Men should always stand up and be Men."

Lawrence was an active participant in our Sunday School bible study and always had a "powerful" desire to understand the Word. Among his favorite things was good music, (Jazz especially), and of course, he enjoyed spiritual songs. A few of his favorites, as we remember he would request them often was, "I'm So Glad Jesus Lifted Me" and "Glad To Be In This Service, One More Time."

Lawrence was very disappointed when illness did not allow him to attend services and was dearly missed by the members of the South Side Church, and fervently mentioned and remembered in our prayers.

The purchase of a new Cadillac was another of his favorites. Traveling to Las Vegas for his birthday was something he looked forward to every year.

Lawrence very peacefully went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, November 18, 2020, after a lengthy illness, very proud to be a servant in the Army of the Lord.

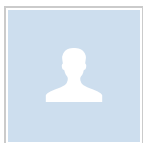

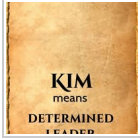
