WATSON, Mr. Lawrence Webster - Age 59, passed away Tuesday, March 1, 2022, at Medilodge of Grand Blanc. Family hour 11:00 AM Saturday, March 12, 2022, at Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, 424 Kennelworth Ave., with funeral service commencing at 12:00 PM. Interment Crestwood Memorial Cemetery, 2020 E. Hill Rd., Grand Blanc, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11:00 AM Saturday. Mr. Watson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday. Mr. Lawrence Webster Watson was baptized at an early age at Foss Avenue Baptist Church. He attended many churches including Canaan Baptist Church, Mt. Olive Baptist Church, and Mt. Nebo Missionary Baptist Church. Lawrence Webster Watson graduated with the "Class of 1980" at Elizabeth Ann Johnson Memorial High School of Mt. Morris, MI. He was an outstanding Basketball player and he even has a mural painted of him at the school showing off his signature shot. Larry furthered his education at Mott Community College earning his Associates Degree in Criminal Justice, Baker College of Flint, earning his Bachelors Degree in Business Administration, MI State University earning his Masters Degree in Agricultural and Extension Education/Science, and Saginaw Valley State University earning his Certification in Administrative/Principal and Restorative Justice. Larry owned several businesses "Lo's Apparel" and "G.A.P (Growth and Achievement Program)" and he had several jobs throughout his life most recently as a Behavioral

Specialist at Brownell Elementary for Flint Community Schools, Interim Principal at Atlantis Alternative High School in Flint, MI, and Behavior Interventionist, Director/Principal of Ruben Daniels Alternative/Continuing Education for the Saginaw School District. Larry's accomplishments were creating a book called, "A Fish Tale" and he was in the process of updating it for publication, State Student Summit at the capitol in Lansing, Michigan for schools in Flint, Beecher, Saginaw, and Muskegon, MI with the assistance of the late Vera Rison, Brenda Carter, and his cousin Ivory Morris. The Student Summit gave the students an opportunity to listen to Congressmen and other professionals for an all-day event. While supervising for G.A.P (Growth and Afrocentric Program) in Saginaw, he mentored young African American students and was part of the Sister City group that took several students to Nigeria in 1995. Through his many travels, work and school, he was part of Saginaw's Sister Cities and traveled to Mexico numerous times and also through his Master's Degree Program for MSU, he traveled to one of his favorite countries Belize.

Larry met the love of his life Sherry at the beginning of their senior year of high school in August of 1979 through her brother Alvin (Wyne) Sewell while working at Wendy's. He was introduced to her as "Larry" and on August 30, 1979, he came to her home to serenade her with his Bass Guitar and his Cowboy hat, and then seven years later, they were married on August 30, 1986. They had just recently celebrated 35 years of marriage. They have three children Lawrence II "Son", Kiara "KiKi", and Micque "Kaykie" and eventually he became "Paw Paw" to Rashawn "RJ" RaMelo "Melo", and most recently his first granddaughter Ryleigh.

Larry would often tell his children "The things you do the most are the things you do the best". The things Larry did the most and the best consisted of fishing, playing the bass guitar, bringing people together, planning family reunions which he received a "proclamation from singer Martha Reeves of the city council for honoring his cousin the late Wilson Pickett for being the organizer for the Mitchell-Pickett Family Reunion in August 2005 in the City Of

Detroit, singing, dancing, telling stories, gardening, skating, playing karaoke, watching his favorite fishing shows, Al Linder and Bill dancing, watching the news on Sundays and after work, playing basketball, swimming, jump roping, teaching children to flying kites in the neighborhood, and videotaping and taking pictures for his cousin Bo Watson's group, "Midnight Star", and taking his RV to the Chematogan Campground in Ontario, Canada. Larry never met a stranger no matter where he was traveling, he would always run into someone he knew out of town and would talk until he found out how they were connected. He would often help neighbors out ranging from lawn care, providing vegetables from his garden and a bag of fish. 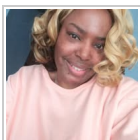

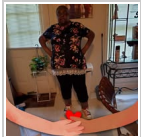
