GLOVER, Mr. Ledge - Age 75, passed away Monday, January 28, 2013 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, February 2, 2013 at Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, 4805 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Rev. Dr. Henry L. Fuller, Jr., officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Saturday. Mr. Glover will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Mr. Ledge "PaPa" Glover was born April 9, 1937 in Waynesboro, Mississippi, the son of the late Percy Pearl and Ora Lee Glover. He graduated from Waynesboro Vocational High School in Waynesboro, Mississippi, "Class of 1956." Mr. Glover united in marriage to Mildred Glover in 1965; soon thereafter they relocated to Flint, Michigan. He retired from Flint Buick City, a division of General Motors and was a member of UAW Local #599. Mr. Glover "PaPa" was a loving, caring and strong man, who showed his love to everyone he met. He especially loved fishing, hunting, and spending time with his children and grandchildren. Mr. Glover began his walk with Christ at an early age with Magnolia Missionary Baptist Church, where he still holds his membership upon his relocation back to Flint, Michigan 2 months ago.
