STROZIER, Mr. Lee- Age 89, passed away Friday, July 30, 2010 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30a.m. Friday, August 6, 2010 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11a.m. Rev. George Dunigan, Officiating. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, G-5175 E. Bristol Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10:30a.m. Friday. Mr. Strozier will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed 12Noon-8p.m. Thursday. Mr. Lee Strozier the son of Phillip and Alice Strozier was born September 26, 1920, in Greenville, Georgia relocating to Flint, Michigan in 1946. Lee was united in Holy Matrimony to the late Elvira Stinson on January 2, 1945 at Mount Zion Baptist Church, in El Paso, Texas and remained married until her death on January 26, 2006. To this union four children were born. Lee accepted the Lord Jesus Christ at Branch Heaven Baptist Church in Odessadale, Georgia at an early age. After moving to Flint, MI in 1946 he became a loyal and faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church. Mr. Strozier served in the US Army during WWII and was Honorably Discharged in 1946. He was employed by the General Motors Corp at the Chevrolet Plant retiring after 34 years of service in 1979. Mr. Lee Strozier leaves to rejoice his life: son, Mr. Horace (Patsy) Strozier; 3 daughters, Mrs. E. Scott (Orea) Peterson, Mrs. Marsha (Robert) Wesley, all of Flint, and Ms. Alma Strozier of Pontiac, MI; 4 grandchildren, Blakely Peterson of Flint, LaShonda Strozier of Atlanta, GA, E.
