HUGHLEY-FLANIGAN, Mother Leera M. - Age 74, after a brief illness, made her transition, Thursday, January 20, 2011 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, January 29, 2011 at North Star Baptist Church, 1657 E. Broadway St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor James O. Flowers, Sr., officiating. Interment Crestwood Memorial Cemetery, G-2020 E. Hill Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Saturday. Mother Flanigan will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Friday. Mother Leera Hughley-Flanigan was born June 15, 1936 in Waycross, Georgia to the late Johnnie Mae Armstrong and Roosevelt Williams. She was also the stepdaughter of the late Willie Lee Armstrong.
