Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Thursday. Ms. Hayden will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 Noon-8 p.m. Wednesday. Ms. Leigh Ann Hayden was born October 8, 1957 in Flint, Michigan the daughter of Harold and Margaret Hayden. Leigh Ann graduated from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1975", and attended general courses at Baker College of Flint. She loved to travel and in the 1990's, she moved to St. Thomas, Virgin Islands where she was employed by the local jewelry industry. Leigh Ann later moved back to Flint to be with her family, where she worked as a Veterinarian Assistant. She was a "Diva" at heart and loved fashion, makeup and shoes, but most of all she loved University of Michigan Football where she was a devoted fan.
