Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10AM-8PM Sunday. Sis. Lelia Mae Johnson was born January 11, 1918 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, the daughter of Fulton and Cora (Carter) Tims. She has been a resident of Flint, MI since 1944 and was a member of Canaan Baptist Church where she served on the Usher Board, Mission Union, Sunday School Teacher and sang with the choir. Sis. Johnson was a member of the Great Lakes Baptist District Association Women's Auxiliary, where she served on the Hostess Committee. She was very active in the community church affairs. Sis. Johnson worked at Hurley Medical Center in the Laundry, which was located in the building that is now called the Boiler Room. In February 24, 1978, she was named Employee of the Month with 32 years of service. Sis.
