“ The older I get the more I treasure the stories of my elders. Here is one of my favorites.

My Uncle Archie told me as a young married man in the 1980s that when he married my Aunt Lenora that they were told that they were too young to be in love. He told me about a Nat King Cole song entitled “Too Young” that expressed so romantically that there is no such thing as being too young to be in love. The proof is in the endurance of the love.

But it took me hearing Natalie Cole's remake of her father's song “Too Young” in the early 1990s before I realized that my Uncle Archie was telling me that what he saw in his marriage to his wife Lenora he saw in my marriage to my wife Dee. I was 21 when we married in college in 1979. Dee was 20. That was 40 years ago. Whenever I hear the song “Too Young” I think of the young and enduring love of Archie and Lenora and Eldred and Dee.

But there is more to this story. When the Lord called my beloved Uncle Archie home to be with Him in 1996 he left a grieving widow who still was too young not to be in love. In other words there is no such thing as being too old to be in love either. This very instructive and insightful lesson that I learned from my beloved Aunt Lenora is that even with the passing of a loved one that life goes on for the grief stricken. My Aunt Lenora made the most of her remaining life and found love again. This spoke of her courage and fortitude. This spoke of her zest for life. This spoke of her faith in Christ who came that we might have life and that more abundantly.

I now speak as an elder. We do well to take heed to my beloved Aunt Lenora's example and do likewise. We are going to miss her but to truly honor her memory would be not to mourn as those who have no hope but to live our remaining lives abundantly.

May we take comfort and find strength in Him who is Resurrection and Life!
