BYOUNE, Mr. Leo - Age 77, passed away Saturday, July 18, 2020 at his residence. Mr. Byoune will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. There will be no public viewing. The funeral service is private and limited to family only. Mr. Byoune was Honorably Discharged from the United States Army. Mr. Leo W. Byoune entered into eternal rest on July 18, 2020 after a short illness. Leo was the fifth of six children born to Elmena (Green) and Rev. Vernon S. Byoune of October 7, 1942. As a young boy at the age of 12, Leo opened his heart to the Lord to receive Jesus Christ as his Savior. Leo attended John W. Gaines High School in Montgomery, Louisiana and received a Bachelor of Science in Education from Southern University, Baton Rouge, LA and a Commission as Second Lieutenant in the United States Army. He served tours in Germany and France. Leo ended his military career with the rank of Captain. He worked as a Buyer for major retail chains for 25 years before having a 10-year teaching career in Grand Blanc Community Schools. Leo received his Master's Degree in Teaching from Marygrove College in Detroit, MI. He retired in 2005.

After attending Bethel United Methodist Church for many years, he joined in 2003 under the ministry of Rev. Alonzo Vincent. Leo began as a member of the United Methodist Men. He has served on the Trustee Board and Finance Committee. He was a faithful member of the Adult Sunday School Class, often assisting the teacher and always attending church and functions held at Bethel. He was a caring person who loved others and was loved in return by many. 1994, Leo married Mamie E. Moore, that union of over 25 years. He was two step-children, Nicole E. Moore and Joe Moore IV, both of Michigan. He loved them dearly and found joy in helping them moved college dormitory supplies each new year or apartment transitions after graduation.
