BELL, Mr. Leonard Earl - Age 78, passed away Tuesday, December 24, 2019 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 AM Monday, December 30, 2019 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, G-5443 N. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 AM Monday. Mr. Bell will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home 906 W. Mr. Leonard Earl Bell was born on January 30, 1941 in Muldrow Oklahoma, the son of John and Ruth Clay Bell. After graduating from high school in Roland, Oklahoma, he enlisted in the United States Army in 1959. After serving for ten years he moved to Flint, Michigan where he worked at General Motors Institute (GMI). While working for GMI, he obtained his Bachelor Degree from the University of Michigan in Business Management. After graduation, he became a salary employee for General Motors Corporation until he retired in 1997. In his spare time outside of work he loved to work on computers. Leonard also worked as a Tax Preparer for his family and friends. He was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School, drove the church van and taught computer classes. Leonard will be truly missed by all.
