Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Friday. Mr. Leonard Horne was born July 23, 1927 in Sherrill, Arkansas, the son of George and Agness (Lawrence) Horne. Mr. Horne was a resident of Flint since the 1950's. He was a faithful member of New Heaven Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Usher Board, Kitchen Committee and Security Ministry. Mr. Horne was employed at General Motors V-8 Engine Plant for 32.5 years, retiring in 1986 and was a member of UAW Local #659. He attended Mott Adult High School, where he received his High School Diploma in 1996. Mr. Horne enjoyed yard work, gardening, cooking barbecue and frying turkeys. He also enjoyed helping others.
