He attended Livingston High School in Livingston, AL. Leonard was an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict. He was a member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church. Mr. Smoot retired from Fisher Body-Coldwater Road, a division of General Motors Corporation and was a member of UAW Local #326 and John W. Stevenson Lodge #56. Mr. Smoot loved his family. He enjoyed traveling, cars and going to horseraces. He was an avid businessman. Mr. Leonard M.
