ADAMS, Mr. LeRoy - Age 64, passed away Saturday, December 21, 2013 at McLaren-Flint. Family hour 11 a.m. Monday, December 30, 2013 at Flushing Valley Golf Course-Clubhouse, 1124 E. Main St., Flushing, MI. with memorial service commencing at 11:30 a.m. Rev. Roosevelt Brown officiating. Mr. Adams now lies in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. There will be no public viewing.

Mr. LeRoy Adams was born August 1, 1949 in Ozan, Arkansas to Lurane (Jordan) Allen and Andrew B. Adams. He spent the majority of his life in Flint, Michigan with the exception of several joyous years residing in Seattle, Washington. LeRoy possessed an entrepreneurial spirit which included owning a men's clothing store, LeRoy's Clothing, in the Flint area. Later in life, LeRoy was one of Flint's top automobile salesmen. LeRoy was a devoted father. In his leisure time, LeRoy was an avid basketball fan. His passion for the game extended to coaching his daughter's basketball team and creating a basketball league for area girls.
